1. Vasantnao Naik Jayanti

Vasantnao Naik Jayanti is celebrated on 1st July in the Bunts Institute for Higher Education, Junagar. On this occasion, our college Principal Dr. Rashmi Chitlange mam and teaching and non-teaching staff offered garlands to him. Miss Pooja Thorat student of T.Y.Bcom briefed about Life, work & values followed by him & inspiration given by him to farmer's community.

Vasantnao Naik was born in a Banjara family in 1913 in Gahuli village of Yavatmal district in the southern Vidarbha region of Maharashtra. He is the uncle of former Chief Minister of Maharashtra Sudhakarrao Naik. His brother was Manohar Naik who served as a MLA from Pusad. Vasantnao Naik completed his Primary education in the village Gahuli and for further education he took admission in Morris College in Nagpur. After Completing BA and LLB he started working as a Lawyer in Pusad.

Vasantnao Naik was an Indian politician who served as Chief Minister of Maharashtra for 11 years & 77 days. He is to date the longest serving chief minister of Maharashtra. He was the founder and Managing Committee member of the Janta Shikshan Prasarak Mandal. He is considered to be the father of Green Revolution in Maharashtra because at the time of severe draught of 1972-73 he did pioneering work in the field of irrigation, land reforms and farmers' development.

College celebrated his jayanti so that his vision for farmers and his work would inspire students. Many students turned out for this occasion.



2. Event Report: "Pledge for life" Organized by Anti-Smoking Committee, BIHE

Tobacco consumption is turning out to be biggest threat for health in India. Tobacco kills over 13.5 lakhs people in India each year and in Maharashtra over 28% of adults use tobacco because of which 72000 die. Whether consumed via smoking, chewing, or any other means, tobacco proves to be maleficent to human body. It doesn't only affect the lungs but harms all other body organs in different ways. Tobacco is the leading reason for spread of cancer in India. Youth are more susceptible to



tobacco usage due to various bad influences. Hence it is of utmost importance to guide the youth at this delicate age about the harms tobacco can bring and create the awareness among them so as to aid the development of a healthy society. Keeping with the same view in mind Anti-Smoking committee of our college decided to observe “Pledge for Life” programme which was initiated by Sambandh Health India Foundation, Delhi and NSS Unit Maharashtra on 11th July 2019.

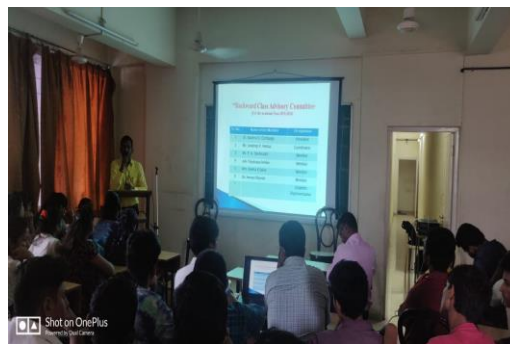
Asst. Professor Parth Joshi, in-Charge of anti-smoking committee, welcomed Principal Dr. Rashmi Chitlange, all the teaching & non-teaching staff and students and then briefed them about the event and the hazardous effects tobacco can bring to human health. Principal Dr. Rashmi mam also addressed the students and proved to them how tobacco acts as an economic burden and social evil. After this the students were shown couple of videos which explained the evils of tobacco on different body organs and parts. Then the students took oath-“Pledge for Life”- asserting their resolution that they will not use any tobacco product or let their friends or family use it. The programme concluded with a quick video of how tobacco effects heart and increases chances of heart diseases.

Around 250 students and all the staff members took oath simultaneously. Upon completion of programme the photos and information of this event were uploaded on the Sambandh Health India foundation’s website.
