Fill the brain with high thoughts, highest ideals, place them day and night before you and out of that will come great work – Swami Vivekananda.


To commemorate the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda, maker of modern India, National Youth day is celebrated with great enthusiasm every year in India.






celebration of National Voters Day.
